

HASKELL COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 3-20-20-5

**A RESOLUTION OF HASKELL COUNTY, KANSAS AMENDING
RESOLUTION 3-18-20-3 RELATED TO COVID-19, GLOBAL PANDEMIC.**

NOW, on this 20th day of March, 2020, a special meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of Haskell County, Kansas, the following resolution is duly made and approved:

WHEREAS, Haskell County issued an emergency declaration in Resolution No. 3-18-20-3;

WHEREAS, the Families First Coronavirus Response Act takes effect on April 2, 2020. Said Act is applicable to Haskell County, Kansas; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 3-18-20-3 conflicts with provisions of the Families First Coronavirus Response Act.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that:

1. This Resolution amends Resolution No. 3-18-20-3 in order to comply with the requirements of Families First Coronavirus Response Act.
2. All portions of Resolution No. 3-18-20-3 not in conflict with the Families First Coronavirus Response Act are still in effect and are not affected by this Resolution.
3. Resolution No. 3-18-20-3 is amended to allow family leave and family leave payments in accordance with the Families First Coronavirus Response Act. Employees will not be required to use either sick or vacation leave under requirements of the Families First Coronavirus Response Act, unless stated so in the act.
4. Haskell County will comply with all requirements of the Families First Coronavirus Response Act.
5. This resolution and all requirements under the same are effective as of March 20, 2020 at 4:00 p.m.
