WHEREAS, both the state and federal governments have declared a public health emergency due to COVID-19 global pandemic;

WHEREAS, Governor Kelly's statewide "stay home" order has been allowed to expire;


WHEREAS, Governor Kelly has implemented a Reopen Kansas Framework plan; and


WHEREAS, it appears to the Board of Haskell County Commissioners that the Governor's plan sufficiently protects the citizens of Haskell County.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that:
